

What are the general precautionary measures during the early childhood?

The precautionary measures to be taken during early childhood are as mentioned below:

- A child must be kept in observation and the body temperature must not rise above 101 degree F, as it may cause febrile seizures (fever fit or febrile convulsion).
- Precautions must be taken against any sort of accidents or head injury.
- Well balanced diets and clean drinking water must be ensured for a child.
- All the immunizations against infectious diseases must be followed in accordance to the immunization schedule.
- A child must be protected from Meningitis or Encephalitis by providing a hygienic environment and avoiding crowded settings.
- In case of noisy environments ear protectors must be used to reduce exposure to high levels of noise.

Dietary precautions must be taken to ensure the intake of well balanced diet and clean water.
