# INTRODUCTION

- □ CP is neurological condition.
- It is congenital disorder of movement or muscle tone.
- It is a permanent condition and non-progressive one.
- The main reason is damage to brain before birth or during process of birth.
- The symptoms are present by birth in the child or during early infancy period.

# SIGN & SYMPTOMS

- Tightness present in upper and lower limbs.
- Oro-facial issues like difficulty in chewing, sucking, eating or swallowing.
- Episodes of seizures.
- Delayed development.
- □ Vision issues.



- □ Intra-uterine growth retardation.
- Respiratory distress syndrome.
- □ Episode of seizure.
- Premature delivery.
- □ Low birth weight.
- Maternal infection or medical condition.



- □ Spastic CP: Stiffness in one part of the body.
- Athetoid CP: Problem with posture, Floppiness in the limb.
- □ Ataxic CP: Shaky or tremors.
- □ Combined CP: Mixed of above mentioned.

### TREATMENT

- Medication: To help and control seizures or for medical condition.
- Therapies: Utmost requirement for the child to learn skills necessary for performing daily routine activities.
- Education: Modified curriculum using proper use of teaching learning aids to build concept understanding.
